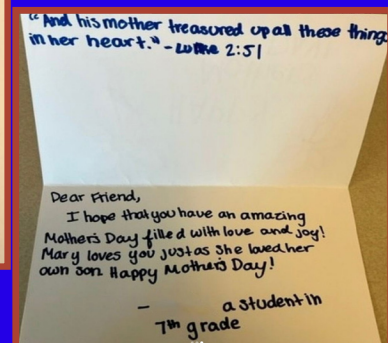


Home Building Dedication

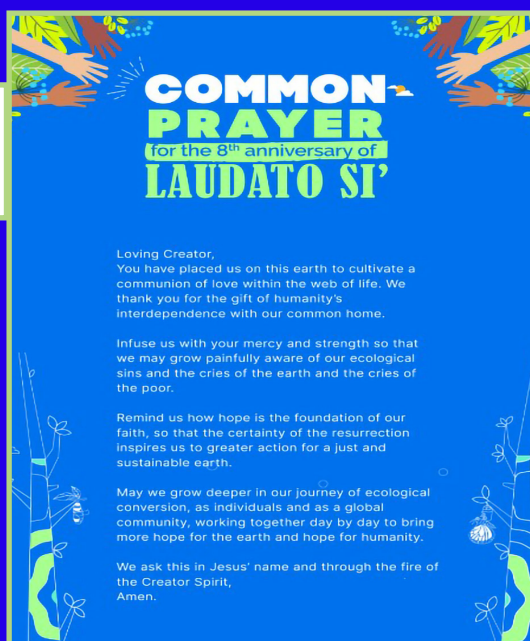

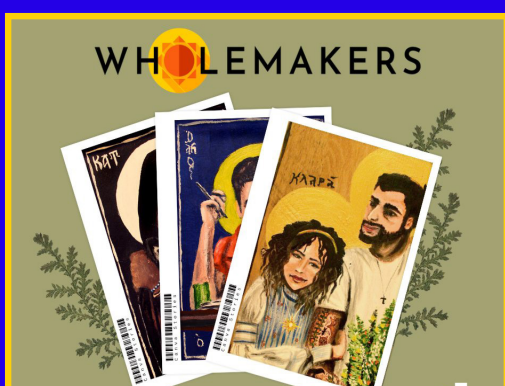
