





World Day of the Sick – Our Lady of Lourdes

The Catholic Church marks the annual World Day of the Sick on February 11th, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

The theme of this year's 32nd observance is, "It is not good that man should be alone: Healing the Sick by Healing Relationships."



Pope Francis calls on all Catholics, "with the love for one another that Christ the Lord bestows on us in prayer, especially in the Eucharist," to "tend to the wounds of solitude and isolation" found particularly among the sick. "In this way," the pope said, "we will cooperate in combating the culture of individualism, indifference and waste, and enable the growth of a culture of tenderness and compassion."
