Dear Marist Friend,

Easter greetings and assurance of our prayers to the friends and benefactors of the Marists!

Members of the Society of Mary are called to make a retreat each year. Venerable Jean-Claude Colin, our founder, reminded Marists that we would be better ministers to others if we maintained a close relationship with the loving God who created us, who saves us, and who lives among us. Mary, the Mother of Jesus, is a model for Marists but also for all people, of a woman who was open to God's presence in her life.

Marist Fathers and Brothers in all these ministries, as well as our senior men, will be praying for you during this Easter season and throughout the year. 
