

On October 27th, 100 Marist students, faculty, and family members gathered for the annual Breakthrough T1D Walk, a tradition started five years ago by Amanda Houston '25 in partnership with Campus Ministry. Participants heard powerful stories from members of the Marist family living with type 1 diabetes (T1D) and the positive impact that T1D research has made on their lives. Following the testimonies, the group walked two miles in solidarity with the T1D community and raised over \$2,000 to support ongoing research and advancements in T1D care. Through events like the Breakthrough T1D Walk, Marist students deepen their commitment to service and advocacy, embodying the school's aim to prepare leaders who make a meaningful impact in the lives of others.
