



From June 15-20th, 29 Marist Fathers and Brothers will attend their annual retreat at the Carmelite Spiritual Center in Darien, Illinois. Other members of the Province, who are unable to travel, will participate in the retreat through recorded sessions sent out each day.

Balay Pasilungan Culminates "Tree of Hope" Campaign


Balay Pasilungan joyfully celebrated its 36th Foundation Anniversary with the culmination of the month-long "Tree of Hope" campaign on May 31st - a heartfelt event rooted in gratitude, simplicity, and renewed commitment to the mission.

Mrs. Maria Elizabeth Jolampong, member of the Board of Trustees, delivered an inspirational message that uplifted the spirit of the community, reminding everyone of the transformative power of love and presence in the lives of children.

Two of the boys courageously shared their personal stories, touching hearts with their reflections of struggle, resilience, and the hope they now carry as part of the Balay family.

The highlight of the celebration was a Rite of Blessing led by Fr. Kevin Medilo, SM, Major Superior of the Marist Fathers in Asia, held in the spirit of Laudato Si. First Bishop Appointed by Pope Leo XIV Visits Balay Pasilungan!

At the end of May, the Balay Pasilungan community was graced with the visit of Bishop-Elect Fr. Miguel Ángel Contreras Llajaruna, SM, a Marist priest from Peru, recently appointed by Pope Leo XIV as Auxiliary Bishop of Callao - the first bishop appointed under his new pontificate.

Fr. Miguel has long served the poor and marginalized in Latin America. With his deep Marist roots and missionary heart, he brings to the episcopacy a love for those on the margins, especially the young and the forgotten. His presence at Balay Pasilungan was a profound moment of solidarity and joy. He prayed with us, blessed our children, and reminded us that the mission we share to protect, heal, and accompany vulnerable children - is a global calling of the Church.
