



Climbing for a Cause



Dr. Mona Hanna, a 2025 USA Today Woman of the Year, was recently on campus to speak to NDP students and staff. She talked about loving others and doing the right thing, even when it is hard. Dr. Mona also spoke about caring for the least of God's people — those in poverty or who cannot advocate for their own health and wellbeing. Her presentation aligns with this year's Marist theme, "Ardent Love of Neighbor."

Dr. Mona is the Associate Dean for Public Health and C. S. Mott Endowed Professor of Public Health at Michigan State University College of Human Medicine, and is the founding director of the Pediatric Public Health Initiative, an innovative partnership of MSU and Hurley Children's Hospital in Flint, Mich. A pediatrician, scientist, activist, and author, Dr. Mona also was named one of Time magazine's 100 Most Influential People in the World and recognized as one of USA Today's Women of the Century for her role in uncovering the Flint water crisis and leading recovery efforts. She also directs Rx Kids, providing direct cash assistance to expectant mothers and infants in Flint to address poverty as a root cause of health disparities.
